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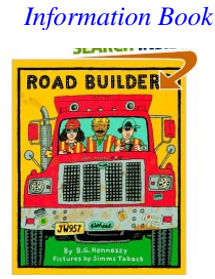
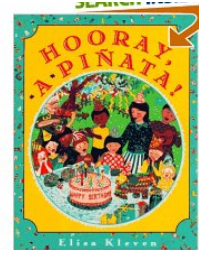
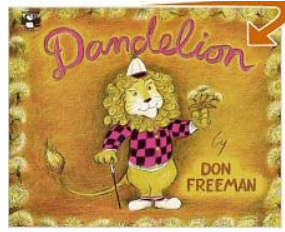
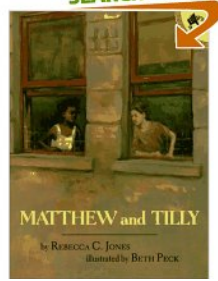
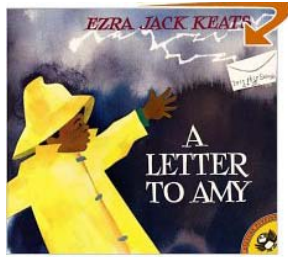
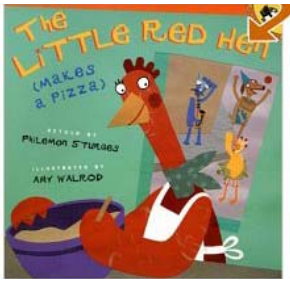


OWL Unit 1: Family* Theme Concepts:**

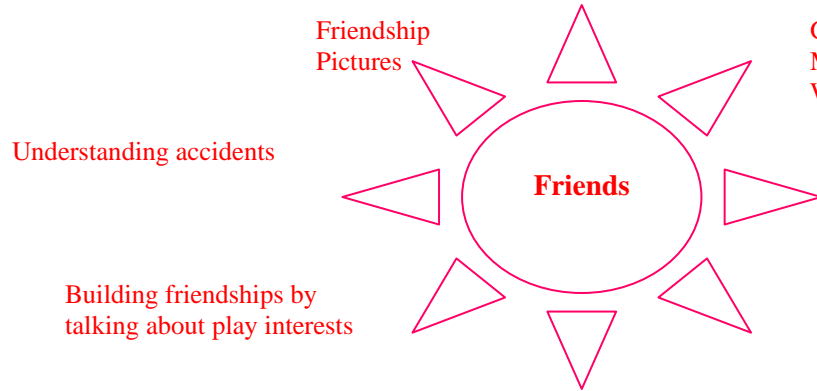
1. Family members have role names: mother, father, sister, and so on.

6. Families do things together that are fun.



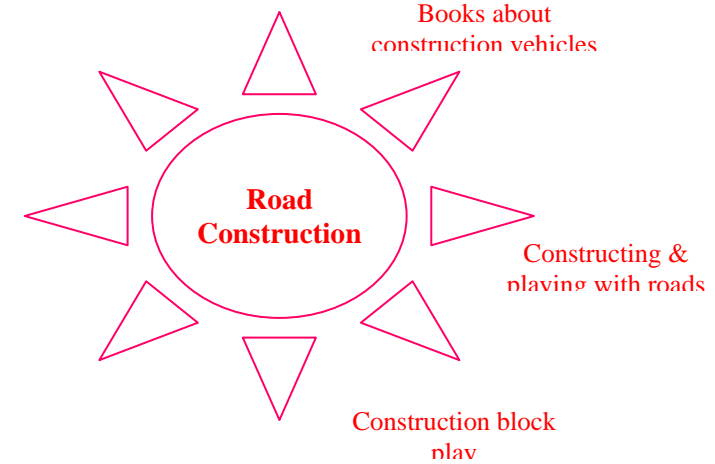
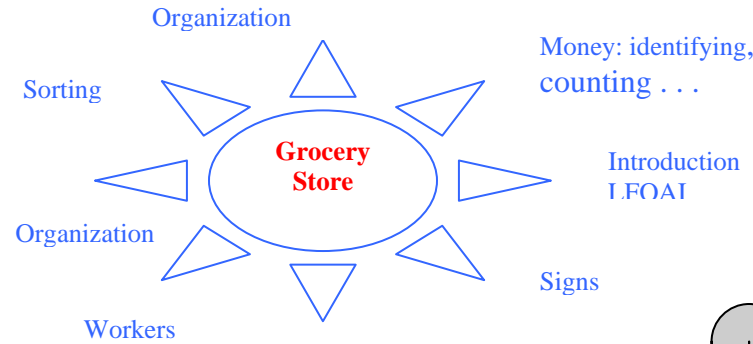

 5. We can make new friends and also keep old friends.



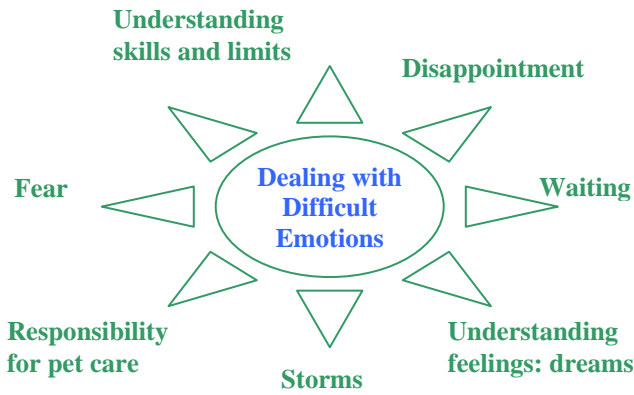
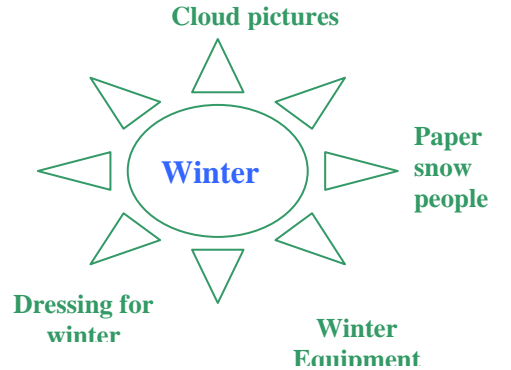
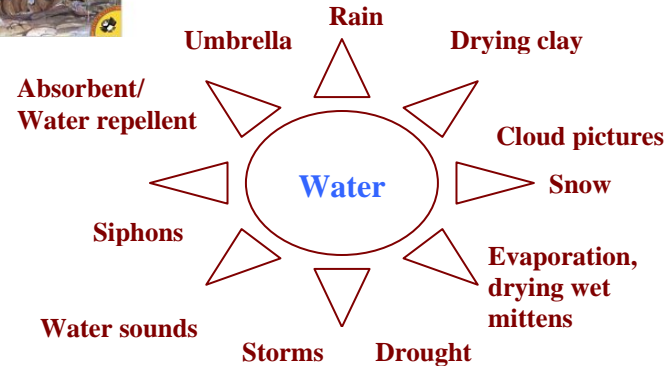
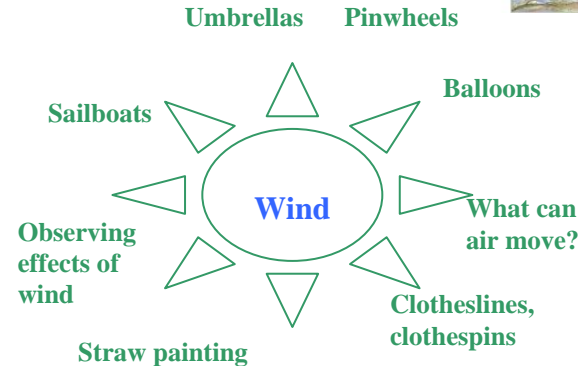
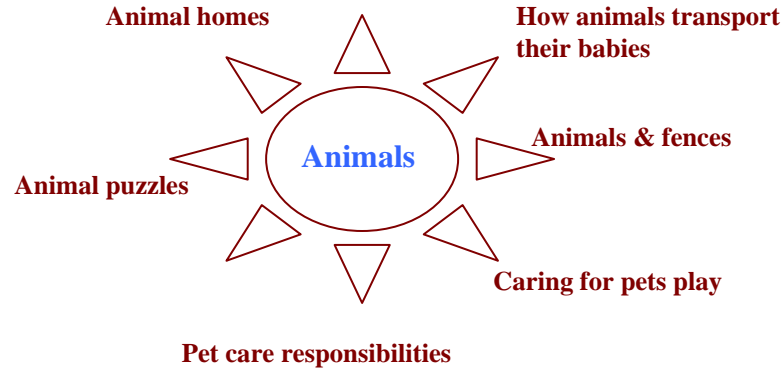


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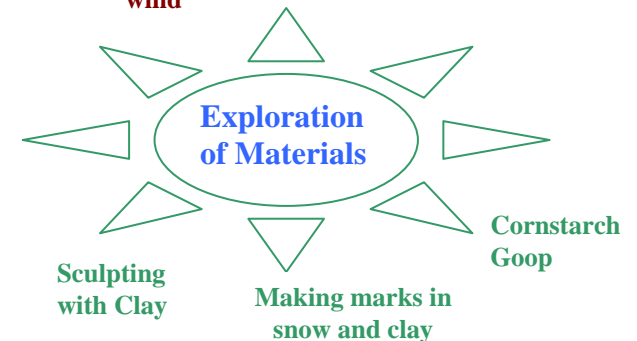
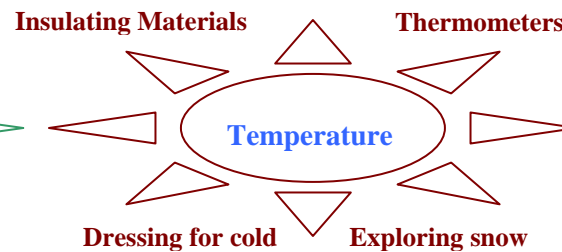
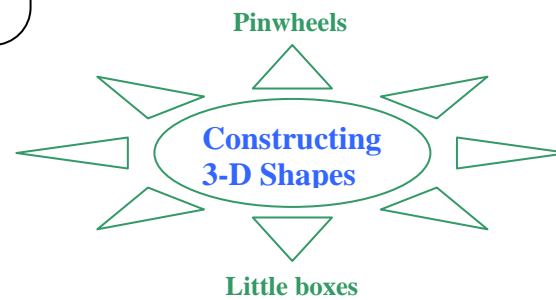
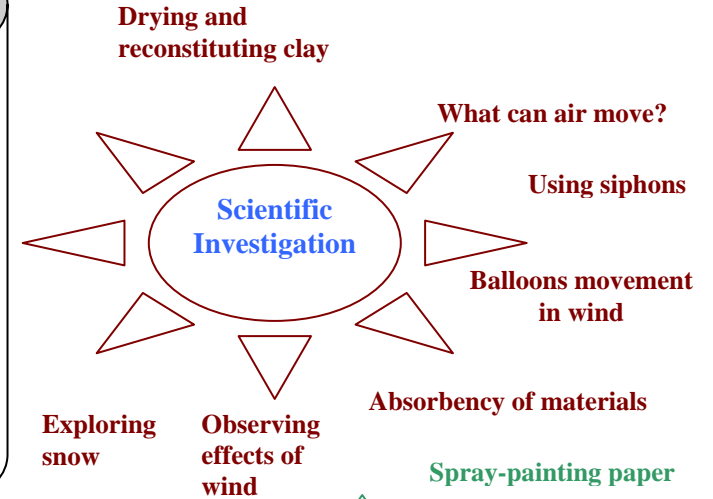

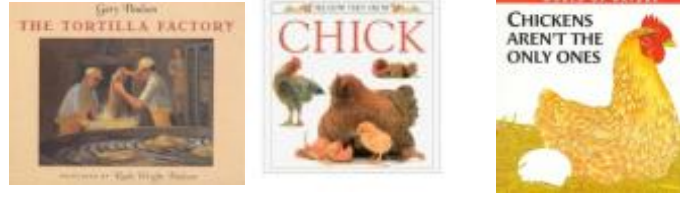
- OWL Unit 3: Wind & Water *** Theme Concepts:**
1. We find water in different forms – as rain (liquid), snow and ice (solid) and as steam (gas). Temperature affects the form of water.
 2. Water soaks into, or is absorbed by, some things but is repelled by others.
 3. Wind – moving air – affects things. Lighter things are moved a lot by wind. Heavier things are moved less by wind. The amount of wind changes with the weather. In storms, wind can blow very hard.
 4. Water comes to us through rain or snow.
 5. Water evaporates from puddles and from things that are wet.
 6. Plants and animals need water to live.
 7. Water and wind provide opportunities for recreation.



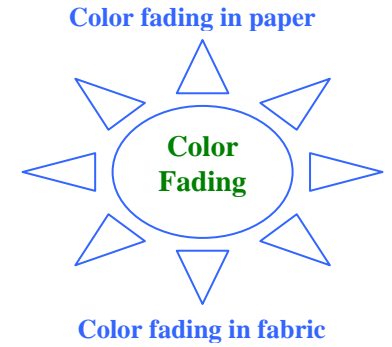
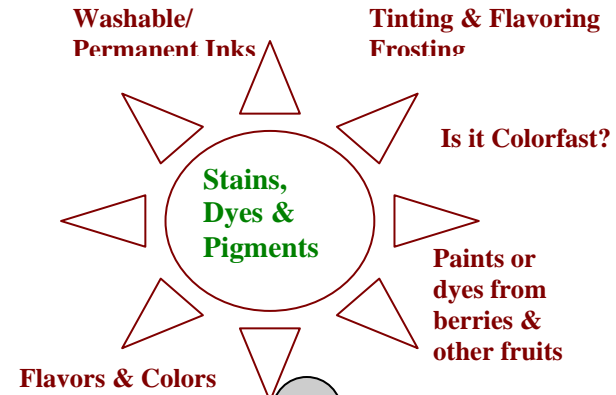
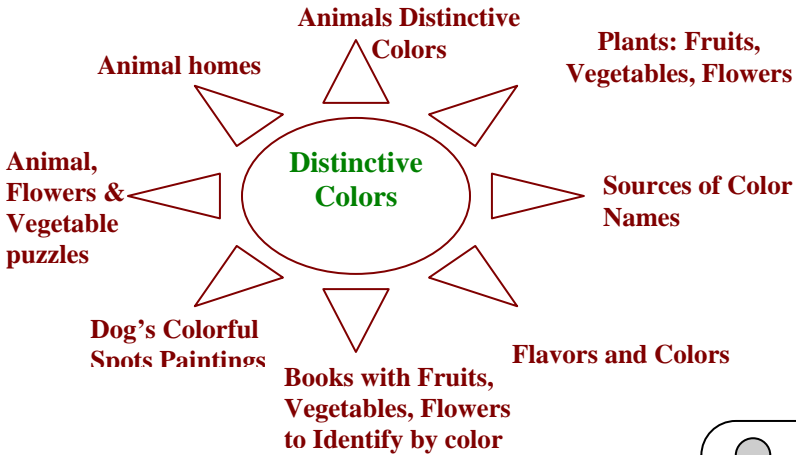

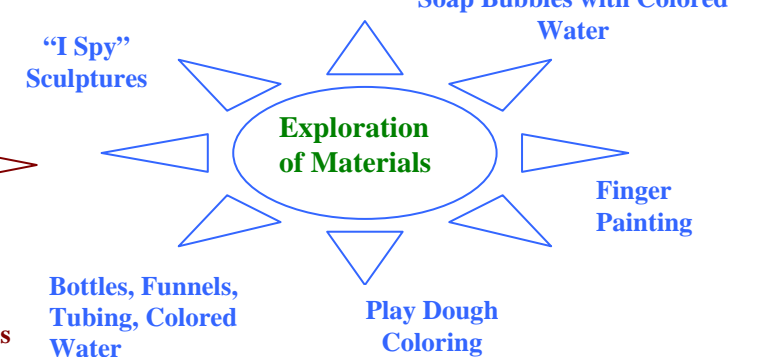


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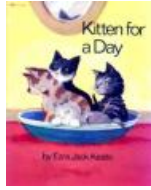


OWL Unit 4: The World of Color * Theme Concepts:**

6. Color is an identifying feature of many natural things.



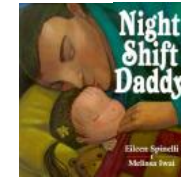

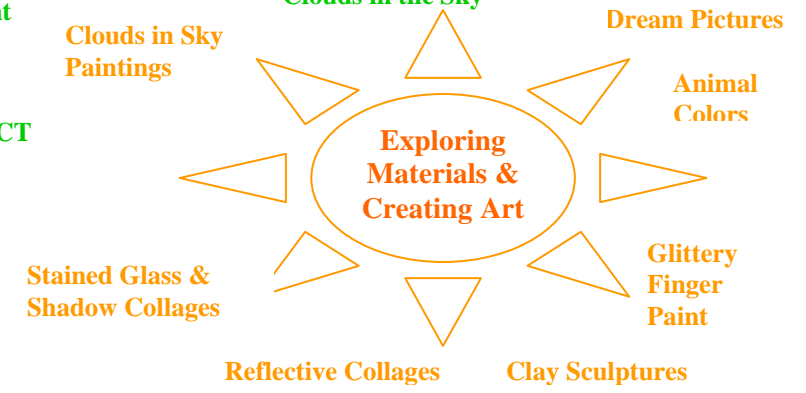
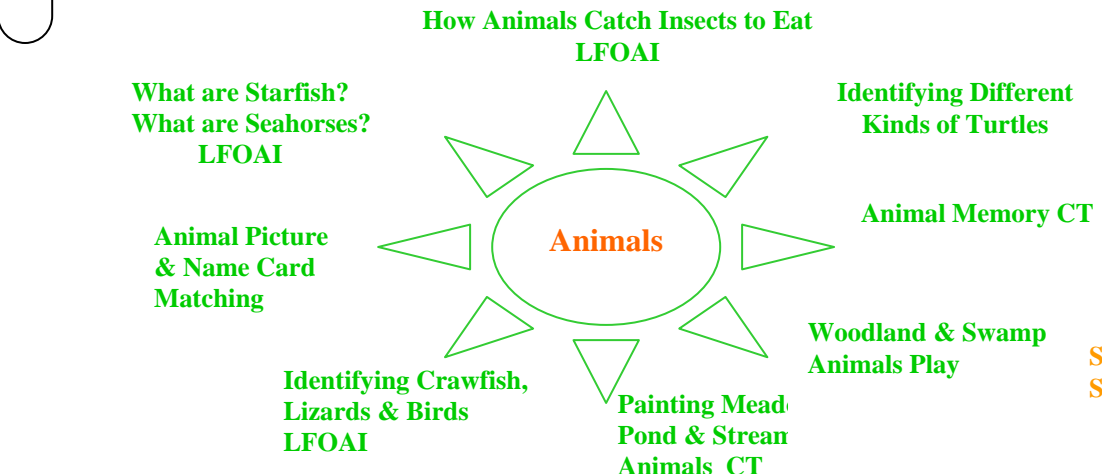
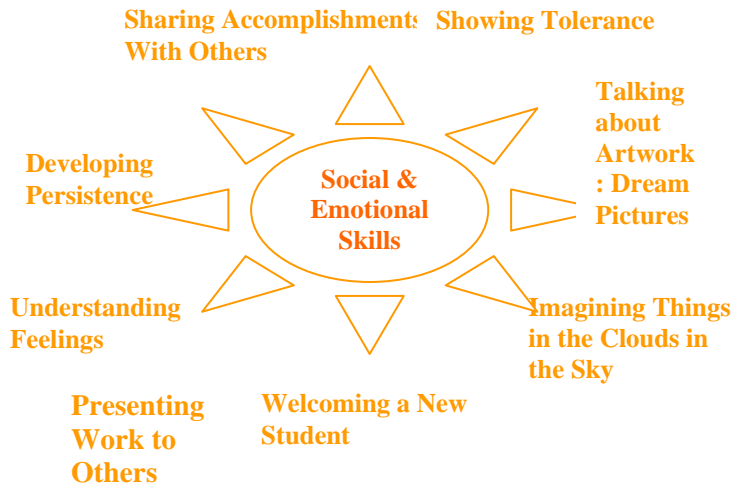
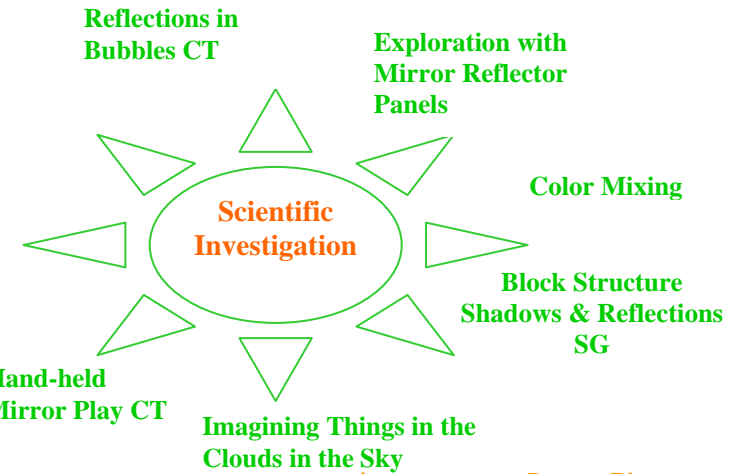


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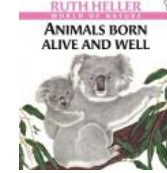
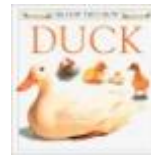
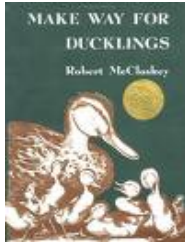
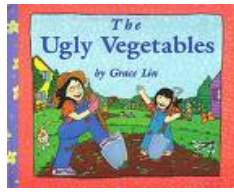


OWL Unit 5: Shadows and Reflections * Theme Concepts:**

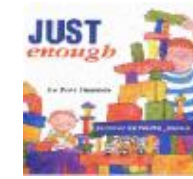
1. Reflections are images thrown back from a shiny surface.
2. There must be light or there is no reflection.
3. Mirrors and still water reflect light well; dull surfaces do not.
4. If water is moving, its reflections are blurry or crooked.
5. Objects are opaque, translucent, or transparent.
6. Shadows are the dark areas made when an object blocks light.
7. The sizes of shadows vary, depending on how close an object is to the light source.



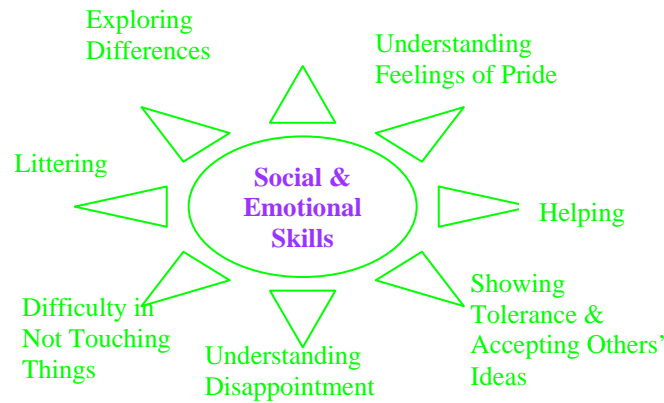
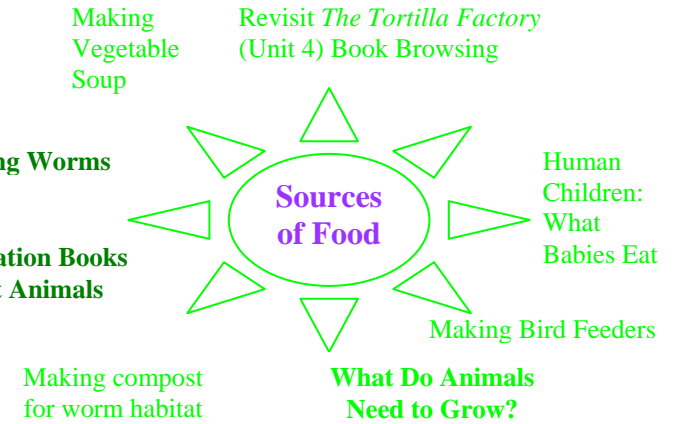
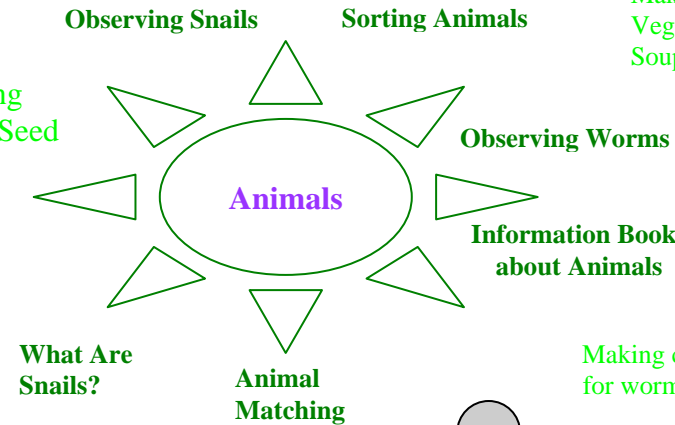
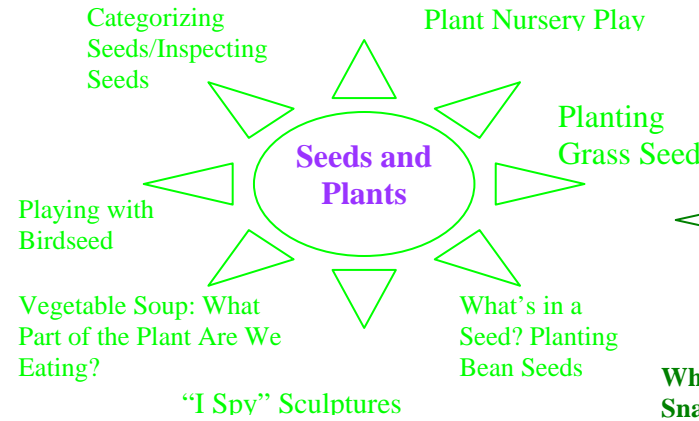
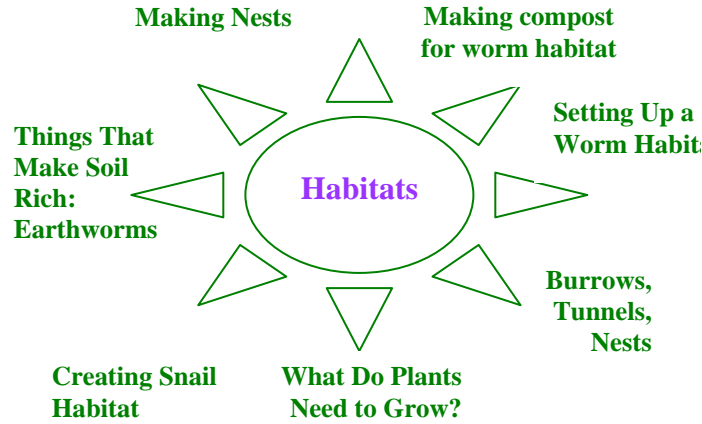
